

Your safety is our top priority at LA DanceMagic. Below you will find a list of protocols we have prepared for our upcoming 2021 Tour. Every city is different and every event will be tailored to ensure we are following all local and state guidelines. A list of city specific protocols will be sent to the registered studios prior to their event. We ask that all attendees adhere to these guidelines for the safety of everyone in attendance.

CURRENT HEALTH STATUS: Anyone with flu like symptoms, a temperature above 100.4 and/or anyone who was in contact with a person confirmed with COVID19 may not attend. In addition, we strongly recommend that anyone with compromised immunity or any underlying health issues not attend.

CLASSES: Ballroom floors will be marked to indicate social distancing. We ask that everyone maintain your space during classes. Dancers should maintain their social distance in between classes and when entering and exiting the ballroom. Ballroom doors will be clearly marked as an entrance or exit door. Dancers should limit the amount of items they bring with them into the ballroom. We ask that studios keep their belongings together in the ballrooms.

BLOCK SCHEDULING: Studios will perform their competition routines in a block schedule, and only that designated studio will be allowed to perform during their scheduled block time. One audience member per competing dancer will be allowed during their studio's block, and will be given a competition pass for entrance. Cleaning will take place in between each block. Seating will be socially distanced, entry and exit points will be clearly marked and must be adhered to. We strongly recommend family and friends take advantage of our FREE LIVESTREAM to support their dancers.

FACE COVERINGS: Face coverings must be worn by all attendees throughout the weekend, in all areas of the venue. While performing in competition, face coverings will be "at your discretion," however all others in the ballroom must wear their face coverings. LA DanceMagic staff will be wearing face coverings at all times. Dancers are required to wear their masks into the backstage area. Prior to entering onstage dancers will be allowed to remove their masks, if they choose. Each dancer will need to bring a ziplock bag labeled with their name. Masks must be placed in their labeled bag and put on the designated mask table backstage. Once their performance is complete, they will need to return to the mask table and put their mask back on immediately.

TEMPERATURE CHECKS: Temperatures will be checked daily for anyone entering the ballrooms, dressing rooms or competition rooms. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or above will not be allowed to enter. Registered participants with a temperature of 100.4 or above will not be able to participate for the entire event. We recommended that all attendees check their temperature prior to arriving at the venue.

LIMITED CAPACITY: LA DanceMagic is working closely with each venue and following guidelines of the local government regarding capacity for each event. To ensure your safety, we are limiting capacity.

OBSERVERS: For the foreseeable future, observers will not be permitted in the ballroom during classes. However, each studio will be provided with one access pass for each ballroom in which they have registered dancers. We recommend that one representative remain in the ballroom at all times. Registered teachers will have access to all ballrooms for the entirety of the event.

DRESSING ROOMS: Each studio will be allowed one parent or representative per 10 dancers in the dressing room. Dressing rooms will be assigned and cleaned in between blocks.

WATER: Attendees are responsible to provide their own water for the entire event.

COSTUMES: Costumes are optional and will not affect scoring. Masks, gloves, and other personal protective equipment will be allowed during performances. This will be left to the studios' discretion.

VIRTUAL AWARDS: All awards will be virtual. Physical awards will be distributed in bulk to the Studio Directors only. Dancers and their families can join us for a virtual awards presentation! Please see your city's schedule for award times.

SCHOLARSHIPS AUDITIONS: Dancers will remain in their class ballroom for scholarship auditions. Dancers will not change ballrooms based on their age. This is an adjustment in our regular audition protocol for additional safety. Scholarship callbacks will take place in their class ballroom.

FACULTY SHOW: The faculty show will take place virtually.

CLEANING & SANITIZING: In conjunction with our venue, LA DanceMagic will provide frequent cleaning and sanitizing.

COMMON AREAS: LA DanceMagic asks that common areas are kept clear and that you refrain from congregating in the hallway/lobby area. The LADM booth will have specific hours of operation posted to avoid congestion in the hallway/lobby. In addition, class start times will be staggered to help keep these areas clear.
